Admission will be just \$10 for any non-SBU students, with I.D.

"We are very excited to be hosting our second Stony Brook University night here at The Jazz Loft," said president and founder Tom Manuel, who is also a recipient of an endowed Artist in Residence Fellow chair within the Jazz department at Stony Brook University. "This is a natural partnership between TJL and the university. After all we are neighbors! We hope to host this event every school semester."

Music will be provided by **the SBU African Drumming Ensemble, Wolfie's Big Band and the Stony Brook Gospel Choir.**

African Drumming Ensemble: Stony Brook's West African Music ensemble is made up of students from several music classes at the university. The ensemble performs music from southern Togo, Ghana and Benin. Students learn to play authentic instruments (drums, bells and rattles), sing, and dance.

Wolfie Big Band: Wolfie's Big Band is a group of musicians that wants to provide free music to all. The band is a student club at Stony Brook University. Primarily a Big Band Jazz ensemble, the students play a wide array of genres including rock, pop, and more.

Stony Brook Gospel Choir: Students bring performances on and off campus as they share the Gospel to those who come and praise and worship in unity.
